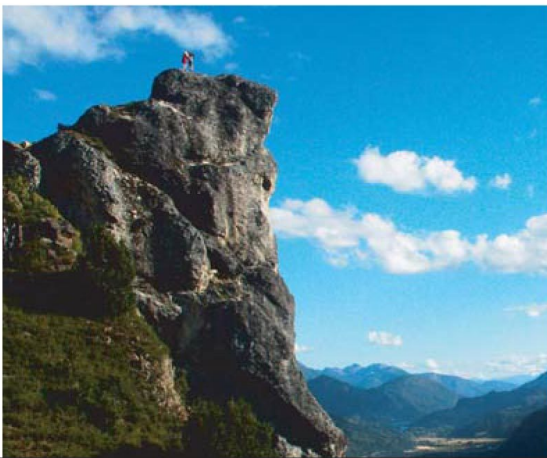


Nestled in a spectacular alpine river valley, in a rain-shadow micro- climate, between the temperate rainforest of Chile's Andes and the arid steppe of Argentina, is Patagonia's best kept trekking secret, the Futaleufu River Valley.

Imagine trekking through a valley so spectacular that it looks like a visual blend of Glacier and Yosemite National parks on steroids, plus a thundering turquoise river carving through it, glaciated peaks, and native forests with unusual looking trees. This is nature in its extreme. Swinging bridges cross the rivers. The occasional isolated road-less settlements offers a cultural glimpse of a time gone by. All this in a climate drier, less windy, and gentler than Torres de Paine National park, and with far fewer visitors.

Our trips allow you to experience all this from the comfort of our Lodge, eco camps and remote ranches. On the FutaFantasy week you return to our Lodge each evening. You select your daily trekking destination as easy, moderate or difficult, or select any of our multisport activities of rafting, fly fishing, horseback riding, mountain bike riding or kayaking. Our 2, 3, 4 day treks offer extended loops and destinations that utilize our eco-camps, and remote ranches.

You can even stay at a high mountain ranch the entire week trekking as you desire. Our seven day Andes to the Ocean trek is for experienced trekkers looking for a once in a life time journey off the beaten trail with camping in the most remote areas.
